A Written Notice of Intent to Issue a Title V Air Operation Permit to the Reedy Creek Improvement District, Walt Disney World Company for the Reedy Creek Power Plant located in Orange County at 1375 Buena Vista Drive, Lake Buena Vista, Florida, was clerked on June 5, 2008. The Public Notice of Intent to Issue a Title V Air Operation Permit was published in the Orlando Sentinel on June 18, 2008. The Draft/Proposed Title V air operation permit was available for public inspection at the permitting authority's office in Tallahassee. Proof of publication of the Public Notice of Intent to Issue a Title V Air Operation Permit was received on July 8, 2008.

COMMENTS

No comments on the Draft/Proposed Permit were received from the US EPA Region 4 Office. No comments were received from the public during the 30-day public comment period. On July 18, 2008, a comment was received from the applicant concerning the July 11, 2008 D.C. Circuit Court issued remand & vacatur order. No changes to the permit are necessary based on the applicant's comment.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

On April 28, 2008, the applicant submitted a CAIR Part Form in order to incorporate the Clean Air Interstate Rule provisions into Title V Permit No. 0950111-029-AV.

On July 11, 2008, the D.C. Circuit Court issued a remand & vacatur order of the CAIR regulations. Due to the vacatur status, the processing of the CAIR Part was stopped. On December 23, 2008 the D.C. Circuit Court issued a remand without vacatur order of the CAIR regulations. The processing of the revision request to incorporate the Clean Air Interstate Rule provisions into the Title V air operation permit is hereby resumed.

FACILITY DESCRIPTION
