Dear Mr Haven:

The Department recently reviewed an annual stack test report for Stanton Unit No. 1 and noted that emissions of air polantants are well below the permitted values. Values of particulate matter, plume opacity, sulfur dioxide and nitrogen oxides were 8, 25, 20, and 70 percent of the respective permitted limits.

The Department commends Orlando Utilities and the employees of the Stanton Plant for preventing pollution by achieving these lower emission rates.

The following table summarizes our results:
