Mr. Krautsch's response to my completeness letter for this project was received on July 20, 2004 and reviewed by this office. The following is needed to complete the application.

1. From permit 0990190-004-AC, Porformance Restrictions, 3. Permitted Capacities: The maximum heat input rate to the gas turbing shall not exceed 63 MMBtu per hour... From permit 0950190-003-\ AV, Specific Condition 1.Capacity. The maximum. shall not exceed 15 MMBcu/hr per engine.

To remove the hourly rates, my supervisor has advised that a construction permit is needed for the other units (001-004) and that application should go to Tallahassee. Until both construction permits are issued, this application will be labeled incomplete. Please provide a copy of construction permit(s) when issued.

2. A staff member of Orange Co. Pollution Control has stated that Engine 1806 and perhaps , another engine is out of compliance with the hourly heat input rate. Please provide a statement about the compliance status of each engine and a compliance plan (application page A-12, number 3) so that the hourly heat input limitations are maintained.

Please provide a compliance plan or evidence of construction permit(s) from Tallahassec semoving the hourly limit.

Pursuant to Rule 62-4.055, the applicant (Mr. Craig) shall have ninety days after the Department mails a timely request for additional information to submit that information to the Department. If an applicant requires more than ninety days in which to respond to a request for additional information, the applicant may notify the Department in writing of the circumstances, at which time the application shall be held in active status for one additional period of up to ninety days. Additional extensions shall be granted for good cause shown by the applicant. A showing that the applicant is making a diligent effort to obtain the requested additional information shall constitute good cause. Failure of an applicant to provide the timely requested information by the applicable deadline shall result in denial of the application.
