


No comments were submitted in response to the public notice. The Department required submittal by FGT Company of the specific gas, heat input rate, and horsepower applicable until the end of the year.

SUBJECT: Florida Gas Transmission Modification Requests

Attached are letters modifying the construction permits for four separate FGT engine units to temporarily increase the maximum power output of Units Nos. 1901 and 1902, 1805 and 2004 due to the vibrational problems and derating of the 5,000 HP Unit No. 1903 reciprocating natural gas compressor engine at the Melbourne Station.

Although the increase of the horsepower will result in an increase of heat input, natural gas consumption, and actual emissions, the emissions from these engines will remain within their respective permitted limits.

It is the Departments understanding that FGT will apply for a permit to install a new turbine at this Station as soon as practicable and that all engines will return to their previous operational mode by December 31, 1997.

The Department is in receipt of your letters dated May 30, June 13 and August 6, 1997 requesting to temporarily increase the maximum power output of Unit No. 2004 due to the vibrational problems and derating of the 5,000 HP Unit No. 1903 reciprocating natural gas compressor engine at Station No. 19 in Melbourne.

The increase of the horsepower will result in an increase of heat input, natural gas consumption, and actual emissions for Unit No. 2004. However, emissions from this engine will remain within their respective permitted limits.

The referenced permit is hereby modified as follows:

## DESCRIPTION

For the construction of one 2,400 bhp natural gas fired engine to be located at the Florida Gas Transmission Facility in Ft. Pierce, St. Lucie County, Florida. The UTM coordinates are Zone 17, 558.01 km East and 3035.68 km North. (The unit may operate at 2,790 bhp until December 31, 1997).

## SPECIFIC CONDITION No. 5

The permitted operating parameters and utilization rates for this natural gas compressor engine shall not exceed the values stated in the application. The parameters include, but are not limited to:

Maximum natural gas consumption shall not exceed 20,569 scf/hr (24,360 scf/hr until December 31, 1997).

Maximum heat input shall not exceed 21.19 MMBtu/hr (25.09 MMBtu/hr until December 31, 1997).



DRAFT Permit Modification No. 0950190-002-AC, PSD-FL163, Florida Gas Transmission Company, Station No. 18, Unit No. 1805, Orange County.  
The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit modification to Florida Gas Transmission Company (FGTC) for the Compressor Station 18, Unit No. 1805, located at 7900 Steel Lake Road, Orlando, Orange County. A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was not required pursuant to Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C. and 40 CFR 52.21. Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD). The applicant's name and address are: Florida Gas Transmission Company, PO Box 945100, Maitland, Florida 32794-5100.  
This project involves an increase in heat input, natural gas consumption and actual emissions for Engine No. 1805 until December 31, 1997 due to vibrational problems occurring on Engine No. 1903 (in Melbourne). The unit burns clean natural gas. Emissions of nitrogen oxides, particulate matter, sulfur dioxide, etc will remain within their permitted limits.  
By increasing the use of the Unit No. 1805, FGTC will be able to compensate for the temporary derating of Unit No. 1903. This will allow FGTC to continue to provide Central and South Florida utilities, small business, residents, etc. with sufficient clean natural gas. This will avoid use of dirtier fuels during peak usage periods by the natural gas customers.  
An air quality impact analysis was not conducted since the allowable emission levels are not exceeded.  
The Department will issue the FINAL Permit Modification, in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit Modification unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.  
The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Permit Modification issuance action for a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the DRAFT Permit Modification, the Department shall issue a Revised DRAFT Permit Modification and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.  
The Department will issue FINAL Permit Modification with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit Modification unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or a party requests mediation as an alternative remedy under Section 120.573 before the deadline for filing a petition. Choosing mediation will not adversely affect the right to a hearing if mediation does not result in a settlement. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below, followed by the procedures for requesting mediation.  
A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, telephone 904/488-9370, fax 904/487-4938. Petitions must be filed within fourteen (14) days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. A Petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any

person to file a petition for a request for mediation as discussed below within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57 F.S. or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-5.207 of the Florida Administrative Code.

A petition must contain the following information:

- The name, address and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed;
- A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action;
- A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action;
- A statement of the material facts disputed by Petitioner, if any;
- A statement of facts that the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
- A statement identifying the rules or statutes that the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action addressed in this notice.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Department on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed action, may elect to pursue mediation by asking all parties to the proceedings to agree to such mediation and by filing with the Department a request for mediation and the written agreement of all such parties to mediate the dispute. The request and agreement must be filed in (received by) the Office of General Counsel of the Department, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 35, Tallahassee, FL 32399-3000, by the same deadline as set forth above for the filing of a petition.

A request for mediation must contain the following information:

- The name, address, and telephone number of the

person requesting mediation and that person's representative, if any;

- A statement of the preliminary agency action;
- A statement of the relief sought and;
- Either an explanation of how the requester's substantial interests will be affected by the action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent or a statement clearly identifying the petition for hearing that the requester has already filed, and incorporation it by reference.

The agreement to mediate must include the following:

- The names, addresses, and telephone numbers of any persons who may attend the mediation;
- The name, address, and telephone number of the mediator selected by the parties, or a provision for selecting a mediator, within a specified time;
- The agreed allocation of the costs and fees associated with the mediation;
- The agreement of the parties on the confidentiality of discussions and documents introduced during mediation;
- The date, time and place of the first mediation session, or a deadline for holding the first session, if no mediator has yet been chosen;
- The name of each party's representative who shall have authority to settle or recommend settlement; and
- The signatures of all parties or their authorized representatives.

As provided in section 120.573 F.S., the timely agreement of all parties to mediate will toll the time limitations imposed by sections 120.569 and 120.57 for requesting and holding an administrative hearing. Unless otherwise agreed by the parties, the mediation must be concluded within sixty days of the execution of the agreement. If mediation results in settlement of the administrative dispute, the Department must enter an order incorporating the agreement of the parties. Persons who substantial interest will be affected by such modified final decision of the Department have a right to petition for a hearing only in accordance with the requirements for such petitions set forth above. If mediation terminates without settlement of the dispute, the Department shall notify all parties in writing that the administrative hearing processes under sections 120.569 and 120.57 remain available for disposition of the dispute, and the notice will specify the deadlines that then will apply for challenging the agency action and electing remedies under those two statutes.

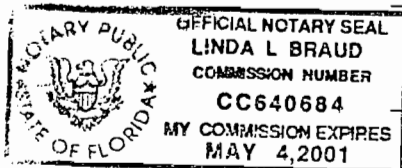

Enclosed is the information section (Section 1) of the Application for Air Permit—Long Form which is needed to modify the construction permits for each of the units identified above. Also, enclosed is a check for \$1,000 to cover the processing fee for the four permit modifications.

This request for permit modifications is based on the need to compensate for lost compression capacity at Station 19 due to vibration problems with Florida Gas Transmission Company's (FGT) 5,000 horsepower (hp) reciprocating, natural gas-fired compressor engine. As you know, the problems with this 5,000 hp compressor engine have been the subject of several conversations, a letter dated May 30, 1997 (letter attached), and our meeting with representatives of the Bureau of Air Regulation on June 11, 1997.

As discussed at our meeting, FGT has several options to restore compression capacity to Station 19 on a permanent basis. FGT is presently evaluating these options and will work with the Bureau of Air Regulation to provide the information and application forms for dealing with the option selected.

The immediate concern is obtaining authorization to allow for the ambient uprating of the Phase 2 and Phase 3 reciprocating compressor engines at Stations 18, 19 and 20. Ambient uprating will only occur during the cool nighttime hours (periods when the ambient temperature does not exceed 80°F). Obtaining authorization to ambient uprate these units will allow FGT to compensate for some of the compression capacity which has been lost due to problems with the 5,000 hp unit at Station 19. This is important, since the 5,000 hp unit accounts for nearly half of Station 19's compression capacity and operation without the authorization to compensate would restrict the natural gas supply to Southeast Florida. Such a situation could impact utilities, industries, businesses, and residences in the area both in terms of a limited natural gas supply and an increase in air emissions, due to the need to supplement fuel-burning equipment with fuels such as oil which do not burn as clean as natural gas.

As discussed at our June 11th meeting, the previous stack tests of the Phase 2 and Phase 3 units at Station 18, 19 and 20 indicate that ambient uprating can be implemented without exceeding current permitted emission limits. Although the permitted emission limits will not be exceeded, ambient uprating, which serves to increase the compressor engine's output, will result in an increase in horsepower, fuel consumption, and heat input. Accordingly, this letter, in behalf of FGT, requests that the permits identified above be revised to not include any limitations on horsepower, fuel consumption, and heat input for a period to extend through December 31, 1997. This will provide sufficient time for FGT to obtain approval, install, and operate the selected option to permanently restore full compression capacity to Station 19. To demonstrate that ambient uprating will not result in the exceedance of any permitted emission limitations, FGT will test each of these units in an ambient uprated condition as part of the annual stack testing that is presently scheduled for this August.

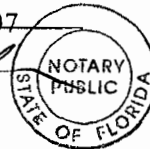

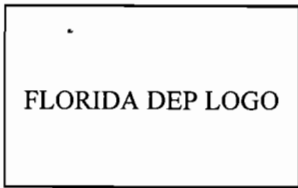

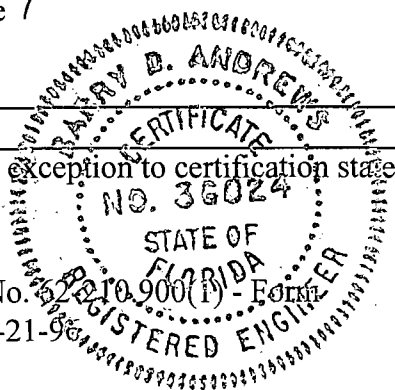

This letter is in reference to your telephone conversation with our air quality services consultant, Barry Andrews (ENSR) regarding the urgent situation that Florida Gas Transmission Company has due to vibration problems that are presently occurring with our 5,000 horsepower (hp) reciprocating natural gas compressor engine at Station 19 near Melbourne, Florida.

As discussed, the 5,000 hp compressor engine is the same unit that was the subject of earlier conversations in which a turbine would be used on a temporary basis (approximately one year) to carry the load of the existing engine. We were in the process of making arrangements with the Central District to discuss the permitting requirements to deal with this issue when it came to our attention that something had to be done immediately.

Based on a review of an engine analysis that was conducted on Wednesday, May 28, 1997, we made a decision today that the 5,000 hp engine at Station 19 must be shutdown to prevent engine failure. We are scheduled to shut this engine down at 9:00 a.m. tomorrow, May 31. Although this measure will protect the engine, it is critical that something also be done to compensate for the loss of this unit.

The 5000 hp engine at Station 19 accounts for nearly half of the total compression capacity at this station. A shutdown of this engine at Station 19 without the option of compensation may severely restrict natural gas transmission to Southeast Florida. This may result in severe natural gas shortages and would impact large users of natural gas such as Florida Power and Light and the municipal natural gas distributors.

To alleviate the potential natural gas transmission problems resulting from the immediate shutdown of the 5,000 hp engine, we would like to have the option to partially compensate for the loss of compression by increasing the horsepower of the two other engines at Station 19 and some of the engines at the upstream compression station (Station 18, located near Orlando) and the downstream compression station (Station 20,

located near Fort Pierce). This increase in horsepower is possible when ambient air temperature is below 80 degrees Fahrenheit, and control limitation are removed from the engine (a procedure known as ambient uprating). Additionally we would like to have the option of increasing the speed of units 1801-1804 at Station 18 and units 2001-2003 at Station 20. The increased speed of these units will not cause any permit exceedances.

This option of boosting horsepower will result in an exceedance of some permit limitations for those engines in which the horsepower is increased. The limitations which could be exceeded include lb./hr emissions limits, heat input and natural gas consumption. It should be noted, however, that the net change in emissions, heat input and natural gas consumption would not increase on a combined basis for Stations 18, 19 and 20, since the 5,000 hp engine accounts for a large part of the overall capacity from these three stations. hp

This notification is being made in accordance with paragraphs (1), (5) and (6) of Chapter 62-210.700 of FDEP Regulations, which address excess emissions resulting from startup, shutdown, and malfunctions. We are predicting that the option of the up-rating measures may need to be taken for a period of four months to allow sufficient time for a temporary turbine to be authorized and put into operation at Station 19.

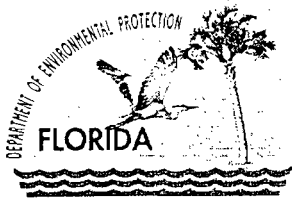

The Department is in receipt of your letters dated May 30, June 13 and August 6, 1997 requesting to temporarily increase the maximum power output of Unit No. 1805 due to the vibrational problems and derating of the 5,000 HP Unit No. 1903 reciprocating natural gas compressor engine at Station No. 19 in Melbourne.

The increase of the horsepower will result in an increase of heat input, natural gas consumption, and actual emissions for Unit No. 1805. However, emissions from these engines will remain within their respective permitted limits.

The referenced permit is hereby modified as follows:

## DESCRIPTION:



An Intent to Issue an air construction permit modification for Florida Gas Transmission Company, Compressor Station No. 19, located at 3400 Ranch Road, Melbourne, Brevard County, Florida, was distributed on June 20, 1997. The Notice of Intent was published in the Florida Today on June 25, 1997. Copies of the modification were available for public inspection at the Department offices in Tallahassee.

No comments were submitted in response to the public notice. The Department required submittal by FGT Company of the specific gas, heat input rate, and horsepower applicable until the end of the year.

The Department is in receipt of your letters dated May 30 June 13 and August 6, 1997 requesting to temporarily increase the maximum power output of Units Nos. 1901 and 1902 due to the vibrational problems and derating of the 5,000 HP Unit No. 1903 reciprocating natural gas compressor engine at this Station.

Although the increase of the horsepower will result in an increase of heat input, natural gas consumption, and actual emissions for Units Nos. 1901 and 1902, emissions from these engines will remain within their respective permitted limits.

The referenced permit is hereby modified as follows:

## DESCRIPTION

For the construction of two 2,600 bhp natural gas fired engines to be located at the Florida Gas Transmission Facility in Melbourne, Brevard County, Florida. The UTM coordinates are Zone 17, 528.67 km East and 3101.64 km North. (The Units may operate at 3,020 bhp until December 31, 1997).

## SPECIFIC CONDITION No. 5

The permitted operating parameters and utilization rates for these natural gas compressor engines shall not exceed the values stated in the application. The parameters include, but are not limited to:

Maximum natural gas consumption shall not exceed 22,703 scf/hr per engine (26,342 scf/hr per engine until December 31, 1997).

Maximum heat input shall not exceed 46.77 MMBtu/hr for both engines (27.13 MMBtu/hr for each engine until December 31, 1997)

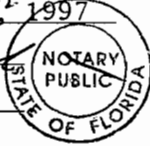

The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit to Florida Gas Transmission Company (FGTC), for the Ft. Pierce Compressor Station 20, Unit No. 2005, located at 8701 Orange Avenue, Ft. Pierce, St. Lucie County. A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was not required pursuant to Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C. and 40 CFR 52.21, Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD). The applicant's name and address are: Florida Gas Transmission Company, P.O. Box 945100, Maitland, Florida 32794-5100.

The project involves an increase in heat input, natural gas consumption and actual emissions for Engine No. 2005 until December 31, 1997 due to vibrational problems occurring on Engine No. 1903 (in Melbourne). The unit burns clean, natural gas. Emissions of nitrogen oxides, particulate matter, sulfur dioxide, etc. will remain within their permitted limits.

By increasing the use of the Unit No. 2005, FGTC will be able to compensate for the temporary decrating of Unit No. 1903. This will allow FGTC to continue to provide Central and South Florida utilities, small businesses, residents, etc. with sufficient clean natural gas. This will avoid use of dirtier fuels during peak usage periods by the natural gas customers.

An air quality impact analysis was not conducted since the allowable emissions levels are not exceeded.

The Department will issue the FINAL Permit Modification, in accordance with the conditions of the DRAFT Permit Modification unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Permit Modification issuance action for a period of 14 (fourteen) days from the date of publication of this Notice. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Permit Modification, the Department shall issue a Revised DRAFT Permit Modification and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue FINAL Permit Modification unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57 Florida Statutes (F.S.), or a party requests mediation as an alternative remedy under section 120.573, F.S., before the deadline for filing a petition. Choosing mediation will not adversely affect the right to a hearing if mediation does not result in a settlement. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below, followed by the procedures for requesting mediation.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. (Telephone: 904/488-9730; Fax: 904/487-4938). Petitions must be filed within 14 (fourteen) days of publication of this notice or within 14 (fourteen) days of receipt of the notice of intent, whichever occurs first. A Petitioner must mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition (or a request for mediation, as discussed below) within the applicable time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with rule 28-5.207 of the Florida Administrative Code.

Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the permitting authority's proposed permitting decision, may elect to pursue mediation by asking all parties to the proceeding to agree to such mediation and by filing with the Department of Environmental Protection a request for mediation and the written agreement of all such parties to mediate the dispute. The request and agreement must be filed in (received by) the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, FL 32399-3000, by the same deadline as set forth above for the filing of a petition.

A request for mediation must contain the following information: (a) The name, address, and telephone number of the person requesting mediation and that person's representative, if any; (b) A statement of the preliminary agency action; (c) A statement of the relief sought; and, (d) Either an explanation of how the requester's substantial interests will be affected by the action or proposed action addressed in this notice of intent or a statement clearly identifying the petition for hearing that the requester has already filed, and incorporating it by reference.

The agreement to mediate must include the following: (a) The names, addresses, and telephone numbers of any persons who may attend the mediation; (b) The name, address, and telephone number of the mediator selected by the parties, or a provision for selecting a mediator within a specified time; (c) The agreed allocation of the costs and fees associated with the mediation; (d) The agreement of the parties on the confidentiality of discussions and comments introduced during mediation; (e) The date, time, and place of the first mediation session, or a deadline for holding the first session, if no mediator has yet been chosen; (f) The name of each party's representative who shall have authority to settle or recommend settlement; and (g) The signatures of all parties or their authorized representatives.

As provided in section 120.573, F.S., the timely agreement of all parties to mediate will toll the time limitations imposed by sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., for requesting and holding an administrative hearing. Unless otherwise agreed by the parties, the mediation must be concluded within sixty days of the execution of the agreement. If mediation results in settlement of the administrative dispute, the Department of Environmental Protection must enter an order incorporating the agreement of the parties. If mediation terminates without settlement of the dispute, the Department permitting authority shall notify all parties in writing that the administrative hearing process under sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., remain available for disposition of the dispute, and the notice will specify the deadlines that then will apply for challenging the agency action and electing remedies under those two statutes.

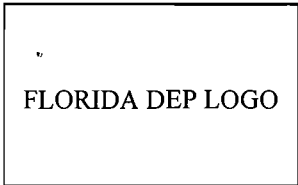
