#### WITHDRAWAL OF REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

not a requirement of the final rule during periods of startup, shutdown, and malfunction." 71 Federal Register 38482 (July 6, 2006).

#### Ronni:

FMPA/KUA will likely renew their request for extension of time to file a petition about their draft PSD permit (Cane Island Unit 4) that otherwise expires on July 21, 2008.

I reviewed and discussed their comments with them and let them know that the present extension is the only thing keeping us from making a final PSD decision.

My understanding is that they don't want the PSD permit to get too far ahead of the Siting process because final issuance will trigger an 18-month period by which they must commence construction. Under the old rules, we would not have issued the final permit until they received their Site Certification.

If they ask for an extension, I would not extend it for too long since I want to finish up this project soon (say by end of August).

You and I also received today a waiver of the permitting time clock from FP&L to take final action on their draft PSD permit for West County Energy Center Unit III.

Note they had received the draft within 90 days and that the 90 days to issue the final permit was based on the conservative assumption that the clock restarts 14 days after receipt of proof of publication.

Following a public meeting held last Friday, we are just about ready to make a final PSD decision.

Their rationale that the additional time will allow the Department to more fully consider comments received regarding the draft permit is true (especially so soon after the public meeting). It will also provide more time for management review of the final documents. However, they are making waiving the clock at their initiative and we did not ask for or suggest a waiver. No action needed.

Again, under the old rules, we would not have issued the final PSD decision until they received their Site Certification.

I'll go ahead and prepare the final PSD decision some time between now and August 1.

On or about May 8, 2008, FMPA received from the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) a Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, a Proposed Draft Permit, and a Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit (Permit No. PSD-FL-400; Permit No. 0970043-014-AC) for the Cane Island Power Park Unit 4 located in Osceola County, Florida.
- 2. The Proposed Draft Permit and Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination contain several provisions that warrant clarification or correction.
- 3. Representatives of FMPA will correspond with staff of the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation in an effort to resolve all issues.
- 4. This request is filed simply as a protective measure to avoid waiver of FMPA's right to challenge certain conditions contained in the Proposed Draft Permit and Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination. Grant of this request will not prejudice either party, but will

further their mutual interest and likely avoid the need to file a petition and proceed to a formal administrative hearing.

5. Counsel for FMPA contacted Toni Sturtevant with the Department's Office of General Counsel regarding this request, and she had no objection.

WHEREFORE, FMPA respectfully requests that the time for filing a Petition for Administrative Proceedings with regard to the above-referenced Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, Proposed Draft Permit, and Written Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit (Permit No. PSD-FL-400; Permit No. 0970043-014-AC) be formally extended to and including July 21, 2008. If the Department denies this request, FMPA requests the opportunity to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings within 10 days of such denial.
