We have information from Osceola Farms regarding their CO test results using method 10.


It is our understanding that Osceola has received a permit modification for its CO limit in its construction and operating permits on their boiler #6.

Our boiler #5 is very similar to Osceola's boiler #6. It is a traveling grate, stoker type boiler with a production limit of 130,000 lbs/hr. We feel that our boiler #5 has both the same operations and approximately the same emissions.

The purpose of this letter is to request that the E.P.A. and D.E.R. modify our boiler permit limitation for CO. We would like to have the same limit as Osceola's boiler #6. Atlantic will be happy to confirm this limit by making some method 10 tests during the 1990/91 crop.

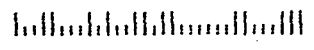
