On September 14, 2006, the Department received your application for a Title V permit revision for the Osceola Farms facility. The application is incomplete. In order to continue processing your application, the Department will need the additional information below pursuant to Rule 62-213.420(1)(b), F.A.C., and Rule 62-4.070(1), F.A.C:

1. The files on the Osceola Farms Company Modeling Files for HBCA Demonstration CD submitted with the application cannot be opened and read and/or viewed. Please submit the information in a form that may be reviewed by the Department. Please submit two copies.

Should your response to any of the above items require new calculations, please submit the new calculations, assumptions, reference material and appropriate revised pages of the application form.

The Department will resume processing your application after receipt of the requested information. Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C. requires that all applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. This requirement also applies to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. For any material changes to the application, please include a new certification statement by the authorized representative or responsible official. As a reminder, Rules 62-4.055(1), F.A.C. and 62-213.420(1)(b), F.A.C. require applicants to respond to requests for information within 90 days or provide a written request for an additional period of time to submit the information.

Professional Engineer (P.E.) Certification Statement: Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C. requires that all applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. This requirement also applies to responses to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. As a result, your response should be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. Please complete and submit a new P.E. certification statement page from the new long application form, DEP Form No. 62-210.900, effective February 2, 2006 (enclosed).
