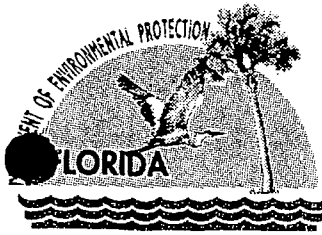

1. The Sugar Cane Growers Cooperative Modeling Files for HBCA Demonstration CD submitted with the application was blank. Please submit this information. Please submit the information in a form that may be reviewed by the Department. Please submit two copies.

Should your response to any of the above items require new calculations, please submit the new calculations, assumptions, reference material and appropriate revised pages of the application form.

The Department will resume processing your application after receipt of the requested information. Rule 62-4.050(3), F.A.C. requires that all applications for a Department permit must be certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida. This requirement also applies to Department requests for additional information of an engineering nature. For any material changes to the application, please include a new certification statement by the authorized representative or responsible official. As a reminder, Rules 62-4.055(1), F.A.C. and 62-213.420(1)(b), F.A.C. require applicants to respond to requests for information within 90 days or provide a written request for an additional period of time to submit the information.
