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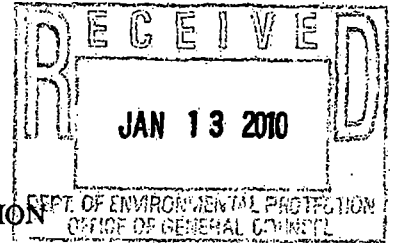

SECOND REQUEST FOR ENLARGEMENT OF TIME

By and through undersigned counsel, Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Seminole") hereby requests, pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rule 62-110.106(4), an enlargement of time, to and including April 15, 2010, in which to file a Petition for Administrative Proceedings in the above-styled matter. As good cause for granting this request, Seminole states the following:

1. On or about November 3, 2009, Seminole received from the Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") an "Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit Modification and Title V Operation Permit Revision" (Draft/Proposed Revision Permit No. 0490340-015-AV and Air Construction Permit Modification No. 0490340-014-AC), for the Midulla Generating Station, located in Hardee County, Florida. Along with the Intent to Issue, Seminole received a Draft/Proposed (Title V Air Operation) Permit Revision, a Draft (Air Construction) Permit Modification, and "Public Notice of Intent to Issue Title V Air Construction Permit Modification and Title V Operation Permit Revision." The above mentioned Draft/Proposed Permit Revision is a revision of existing Title V Air Operation Permit No. 0490340-006-AV.

2. Based on Seminole's initial review, the Draft/Proposed Permit Revision, Draft Permit Modification and associated documents contain several provisions that warrant clarification or corrections.

3. On November 18, 2009, the Department granted Seminole's first Request for Enlargement of Time until January 15, 2009. Seminole filed comments regarding the Draft/Proposed Permit Revision and Draft Permit Modification on December 21, 2009, and is awaiting the Department's response.


4. This request is filed simply as a protective measure to avoid waiver of Seminole's right to challenge certain conditions contained in the Draft/Proposed Title V Permit Revision and Draft Permit Modification. Grant of this request will not prejudice either party, but will further their mutual interest and hopefully avoid the need to file a Petition and proceed to a formal administrative hearing. In the event all issues are resolved prior to April 15, 2010, Seminole will withdraw this Request.

5. If the Department denies this request, Seminole requests the opportunity to file a Petition for Administrative Proceeding within 10 days of such denial.

WHEREFORE, Seminole respectfully requests that the time for filing of a Petition for Administrative Proceedings in regard to the Department's Intent to Issue Title V Air Operation Draft/Proposed Revision Permit No.0490340-015-AV and Air Construction Permit Modification 0490340-014-AC, be formally extended to and including April 15, 2010.
