The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) announces a public meeting in West Palm Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida to which all persons are invited.

The meeting will be held on November 18, 2009 from 6:00 p.m. until no later than 8:00 p.m. It will be held at the South Florida Water Management District, 3301 Gun Club Road, B-1 Auditorium, West Palm Beach, Florida 33406. The purpose of the meeting is to receive comments on the Department's Notice of Intent to issue an air construction modification (Permit No. 0990646-003-AC) to Florida Power and Light Company for the modification of permit conditions related to the existing natural gas fired auxiliary boiler at the West County Energy Center. The existing facility is located in Palm Beach County at 20505 State Road 80 in Loxahatchee, Florida. The purpose of the project is to modify the original air construction permit to recognize that only one natural gas fired auxiliary boiler is installed and to increase the total allowable hours of operation from 1000 to 1500 hours per year for the single auxiliary boiler.

In January of 2007, the Department issued an air construction permit for combined cycle combustion turbine Units 1 and 2 at the West County Energy Center. The natural gas fired auxiliary boiler was authorized as part of this original permit. The function of the auxiliary boiler is to produce steam to cool turbine blades during startup of the combustion turbines. In July of 2008, the Department issued an air construction permit for combined cycle combustion turbine Unit 3 at the West County Energy Center.

The application for an air construction permit modification for the auxiliary boiler is subject to Department permitting requirements including: Stationary Source Requirements - Permits Required pursuant to Rule 62-210.300, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) and Preconstruction Review for the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) of Air Quality pursuant to Rule 62-212.400, F.A.C.

The Department distributed an "Intent to Issue Permit" package on September 10, 2009. The applicant published the "Public Notice of Intent to Issue" in The Palm Beach Post on September 14, 2009. No petitions for administrative hearings or extensions of time to petition for an administrative hearing were filed. This public meeting was requested pursuant to the procedures described in the "Public Notice" and is being held to accept comments on the proposed draft permit related to the permit modification for the natural gas fired auxiliary boiler. Oral and written comments may be submitted at the meeting. All statements will become part of the Department's public record for this project.
