**Objections:** Mediation is available pursuant to 37 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 1616(b)(2) any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 30 days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45-day period to issue a permit for the proposed activity under 37 U.S.C. 1616(b)(2) to object to the issuance of any title, registration or permit. Any petitions shall be based on only on objections to the Permit that were raised specifically during the public hearing held on the day public comment period provided in the Public Notice. Unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator that the objections are specifically attributable to such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filing of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62 213, F.A.C. Petitions filed with the Administrator of EPA must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at 1616(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at 1616(b)(2) M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20460. Objections are fully pursuant to 49 United States Code (U.S.C.) section 6616(b)(2). Any person may file an objection to the Administrator's final decision for the expiration of the Administrator's authority to renew permits established under 42 U.S.C. section 6601(c) or to the permit's terms and conditions any time within the 30-day period following the date of the Administrator's final decision. Objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30-day public comment period provided in the Public Notice, however, will not be considered. Objections to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the 30-day period will not be considered. Objections to the Administrator of the EPA does not stay the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62 of the D.C. Code. Petitions filed with the Administrator of the EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 6616(b)(2) and must be filed with the Administrator of the EPA at the EPA, 401 M Street, S.W., Washington, D.C. 20460.
