Based on our discussion last week, this is just a reminder that the following projects are being processed concurrently as you requested in the applications:

Lake Cogen: Project No. 0694801-014-AC and Project No. 0694801-015-AV

Pasco Cogen: Project No. 1010071-011-AC and Project No. 1010071-012-AV

For the AC permit applications, you have waived the processing time clock so that each on the same schedule as the concurrent Title V application. I'm providing you this email to clarify since the Department's Requests for Additional Information did not specifically include the concurrent AC project number. So, both the Title V and corresponding AC applications are on hold awaiting the requested additional information. Once we receive the requested additional information and the applications are made complete, the draft permits for each pair of projects will be issued together, as a package, with a common public notice for the pair.

On April 4th, I emailed you a pre-draft permit on Lake Cogen (which is essentially a new permit) for your review and comment. Once we work out any remaining issues, I will forward a pre-draft on Pasco Cogen, which will be very similar. Once these are ready to go, I will forward the AC permit package to our Title V project engineers to incorporate into the Title V renewal permits. When we receive the additional information and the applications are complete, the Title V project engineer will issue you the entire package for the draft AC permits and concurrent draft Title V renewals.
