Dear Mr. Koerner:

In preparation for the upcoming hurricane season, Florida Power Corporation dba Progress Energy Florida, Inc. ("PEF") has added an emergency No. 2 fuel oil truck loading station at the P.L. Bartow Plant. This diesel fuel truck loading station would only be used in emergency situations (e.g. hurricanes) to supply diesel fuel for PEF's peaking units at other locations during periods when traditional fuel supply is disrupted.

The trucks will be loaded using the No. 2 fuel oil storage tank head pressure created by the sufficient liquid level in the fuel tank. The emissions from the proposed fuel oil loading activity were estimated using AP42 Section 5.2, "Transportation and Marketing of Petroleum Liquids." The estimated emissions were considerably less than the insignificant threshold of 5 tons per year or more of any regulated pollutant per Rule 62-213.430(6)(b)3.d., F.A.C.
