This letter is in response to your mailing dated 4/5/02 requesting MACT notification information. Our site (Schneller Inc.) is located at 6200- 49th Street North, Pinellas Park, Pinellas County. UTM Coordinates: Zone 17, 322.5 km East and 3079.2 North; Latitude: 27° 49' 30" North and Longitude: 82° 42' 30" West.

The Facility has Operations that are subject to the Section 112(j) emission standard. The specific MACT rule that applies is 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart JJJJ – Paper and other Web Coating.

Schneller Inc. provides decorative laminates to the Transportation Industry. The processes implement solvent coating, knife over roll, on paper and various substrates. The sources include air source EU003, involving HAPS including MEK and Toluene. The facility is permitted under Title V utilizing a thermal oxidizer as control for this source.

Dear Mr. Hudson:

You indicated, in your 112(j) notification dated May 13th, that your facility would be subject to the NESHAP (40 CFR 63 Subpart JJJJ) for Paper and Other Web Coating. You may be interested in knowing that on December 4, 2002 the USEPA published the final NESHAP for Paper and Other Web Coating in the Federal Register.

The compliance date for a Subpart JJJJ "existing affected source" is December 5, 2005. "Existing affected source" means any affected source the construction or reconstruction of which is commenced on or before September 13, 2000, and has not undergone reconstruction as defined in 40 CFR 63.2.

Since 40 CFR 63 Subpart FFFF, Miscellaneous Organic Chemical Production and Processes, has now been promulgated, you will not be required to submit a 112(j) MACT Title V revision application for this source.
