

You indicated, in your 112(j) notification dated May 10th, that your facility would be subject to the NESHAP (40 CFR 63 Subpart JJJJ) for Paper and Other Web Coating. You may be interested in knowing that on December 4, 2002 the USEPA published the final NESHAP for Paper and Other Web Coating in the Federal Register.

The compliance date for a Subpart JJJJ "existing affected source" is December 5, 2005. "Existing affected source" means any affected source the construction or reconstruction of which is commenced on or before September 13, 2000, and has not undergone reconstruction as defined in 40 CFR 63.2.

Since 40 CFR 63 Subpart FFFF, Miscellaneous Organic Chemical Production and Processes, has now been promulgated, you will not be required to submit a 112(j) MACT Title V revision application for this source.
