**Re: Comments on Draft Permit Renewal No. 1050003-011-AV
City of Lakeland's Charles Larsen Memorial Power Plant**

Dear Mr. Sheplak:

On October 10, 2002 Lakeland Electric (Lakeland) submitted a comment in reference to the above as follows:

Permitting Notes regarding heat input rates. Lakeland requests the replacement of the permitting notes with a specific condition at the end of specific conditions A.1, B.1, C.1, and D.1 with the following language to be added at the end of these actual conditions. Based on discussions between the Florida Electric Power Coordinating Group and the Department, we understand that this concept is necessary to clarify these conditions. The following language is intended to be substantively the same as the existing permitting notes.

This heat input rate has been placed in this permit to identify the capacity of this unit during testing, to confirm that testing is conducted within 90 to 100 percent of the unit's rated capacity (or to limit future operation to 110 percent of the test load). See Condition A.21 [or B.21, C.13, or D.36]. This rate is not a limit and therefore regular record keeping is not required. Instead the owner or operator is expected to determine the heat input rate whenever stack emission testing is required, to demonstrate at what percentage of the rated capacity that the unit is tested. Rule 62-297.310(5), F.A.C., included in this permit, requires measurement of the process variables for emission tests. Such heat input determination may be based on measurements of fuel consumption by various methods including but not limited to fuel flow metering or tank drop measurements, using the heat value of the fuel determined by the fuel vendor or the owner or operator, to calculate the average hourly heat input during the test.




