The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its intent to Issue a permit to Corolli Fertilizer, Inc. P. O. 80 x471, Bartow, Florida 3830, to increase the production rate of the No. 4 Diammonium Phosphate plant at their existing facility in Bartow, Polk County, Florida: A determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT) was required. The proposed project is subject to Prevention of Significant Deterioration regulations and federal new source performance standards. The project will increase the annual allowable alammonium phosphate production at the Carolli Fertilizer, inc., facility by 67% and is not expected to result in significant deterioration of the environment. There is a less than significant consumption of PM/PM10 increment. The Department is issuing this Intent to Issue for the reasons stated in the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination.

A person whose substantial interests are afected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, F. S.
