Dear Mr. Nance:

On March 8, 2001, you were sent a first notice concerning non-payment of the calendar year 2000 fees. A third notice was sent to you on September 13, 2001. This is your fourth and final notice for payment.

Because the facility did not operate during calendar year 2000 and the facility still holds a valid Title V operating permit, the minimum fee of \$250.00 was due. Since it is past March 1, 2001 and the required fee was not received, the balance due is subject to a 50% penalty plus 0.917% interest per month or part of a month past March 1, 2001 that the correct fees are not received [Rule 62-213.205(1) (g), F.A.C.]. Therefore, if your remaining balance is paid by November 30, 2001, the total amount due will be:

$$\$250.00 + 125.00 + [250.00 \times 0.07333] = \$393.33$$

Should the facility wish to surrender the active Title V permit, which expires on December 31, 2004, the Department would be willing to cease efforts to collect the Calendar Year 2000 Annual Emissions fee due. Failure to submit the balance due of the Calendar Year 2000 Annual Emissions fee could result in the revocation of the Title V permit.
