

In response to your letter dated April 5, 2002, regarding the possibility of this facility being subject to the notification requirements under what is known as the MACT Hammer. This is **not a** notification of applicability under Section 112(j) of the Clean Air Act. Our current Title V permit incorrectly contains the statement, "Based on the initial Title V permit application received June 14, 1996, this facility is a major source of hazardous air pollutants (HAPs)" (Section I, Page 2). We are in the process of correcting this error and do not believe that we are an affected facility under this rule.
