

Department of Environmental Regulation gives notice of hits intent to issue a permit (AC 53-207438) to Agrico Chemical Company, P. O. Box 1110, Mulberry, Florida 33860, to construct a foundation installation project which includes some electrical lines and piping, at Agrico's South Pierce phosphate fertilizer chemical plant located south of Mulberry on State Road 630 in Polk County, Florida Fugitive dust caused by the construc tion will be controlled by the application of water. The regulations do not require a Best Available Control Technology (BACT) or Lowest Achievable Emission Rate (LAER) determination for this project. The unconfirmed emissions will not violate any ambient air quality standards. The Department is issuing this Intent to issue for the reasons stated in the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of ! General Counsel of the Department at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, within (14) days of publication of this notice. Petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. Failure to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right such person may have to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Section 120.57, Florida Statutes.

The Petition shall contain the following information; (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by Petitioner, if any, (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
(f) A statement of which rules or statutes" petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Depart-

ment's action or proposed action.

If a petition is filed, the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate agency action. Accordingly, the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Notice Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any decision of the Department with regard to the application have the right to potition the property actions and the process of th
