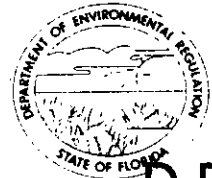

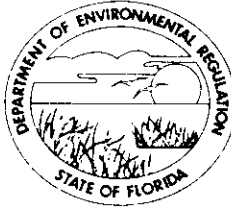

The department has received and reviewed your letter dated June 5, 1985, for an extension of the expiration date of the above referenced permit.

The department is in agreement with your request for an extension and the following changes and additions should be incorporated in the permit.

Expiration Date Change:

From: November 20, 1985  
To: November 20, 1987

Specific Condition No. 21 Change:

From: Agrico is aware of a pending inquiry by the department into development of a rule concerning sulfur transportation, handling and storage and acknowledges that the rule ultimately adopted could, if made applicable to this category of sources, require substantial modification of the facility which is the subject of this permit. Agrico agrees to comply with any such rule within the time period established within the rule, or, if not so specified, on a reasonable time schedule developed between the permittee and the department. Agrico, by accepting this condition, does not waive its rights to participate in rulemaking proceedings nor to appeal or otherwise challenge the validity (as opposed to the applicability) of the adopted rule.



Dear Mr. Fancy,

This letter is to request an extension of the expiration date of Permit AC53-55780, which was issued for the construction of a prilled sulfur handling and melting facility at the South Pierce Chemical Works. This permit was issued on April 20, 1984 and will expire on November 20, 1985. As a condition of the permit, construction of the facility is to be completed by August 22, 1985.

At the time of issuance we were unable to make a commitment on construction due to the anticipated objections, litigation and rulemaking. These actions introduced a degree of uncertainty into the project which rendered it impractical to commence construction. Now that the Department has adopted rules concerning the handling of solid sulfur, much of the uncertainty has diminished. Unfortunately, there is now insufficient time to complete construction of the installation prior to the expiration date.

For these reasons we request the permit be extended for a period of 24 months, to November 20, 1987. Should you have any questions regarding this request, please feel free to contact me at (813) 428-1423.
