MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rule 17-1.29, Agrico Chemical Company respectfully requests that the Secretary grant an extension of time to file a Petition for Administrative Hearing and Notice of Proposed Agency Action, and in support would state:

1. On November 21, 1982, Agrico Chemical Company received notice that the Department of Environmental Regulation intended to deny the above-referenced permit application. In order to supply the additional information requested by the Department, Agrico voluntarily extended the permit review deadline in Section 120.60, Florida Statutes, to February 28, 1983, and moved the Department to extend the time to petition for administrative hearing. On December 6, 1982, the Department granted Agrico's motion and extended the deadline for filing a petition for administrative hearing to March 31, 1983.

2. In a letter dated March 17, 1983, from the Chief of the Bureau of Air Quality Management, Steve Smallwood, to Agrico's consultant, Dr. Dale Lundgren, the Department requested additional information in connection with this permit application. In order to prepare a response to this letter, Agrico sought and was granted extensions of the filing deadline, first to May 16, 1983 and later to July 15, 1983.

3. On July 5 , 1983. Dr. Dale Lundgren submitted his response to the Department's March 17, 1983 letter. The Department has indicated that it will need additional time to review this material. Consequently, it will be necessary for the Department to further extend the filing deadline to August 16, 1983.

WHEREFORE, Agrico Chemical Company respectfully requests that the deadline for filing a Petition for Administrative Proceeding on the Department's Notice of Intended Agency Action be further extended to August 16, 1983.
