

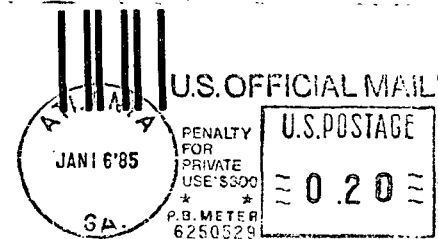
Please submit copies of the final determination and permits when they are issued.
