NOTICE OF PERMIT

In your letters of April 19, 1990 and August 21, 1990 you notified the Department of Environmental Regul DERo BAOM your replacement of the baghouse included on permit A053-156338 (Multifos Product Classification System) and your modifications to the particulate matter control duct work on permits A053-156337 (Multifos Milling & Sizing) and A053-160175 (Multifos Dedusting System). Based on these letters, discussions with your staff and a plant inspection by DER personnel, it has been determined to incorporate the above changes by consolidating the permits for the Multifos Plant milling and sizing operations into one operation permit. To accomplish this a revised permit A053-156337 is being issued to replace the above three operation permits and include all of the operations associated with multifos milling and sizing.

Enclosed is revised and reissued Permit Number A053-156337 to operate the Multifos Plant milling and sizing operations at the IMC Fertilizer, Inc. fertilizer and animal feed plant located near Mulberry in polk County, issued pursuant to Section 403, Florida Statutes.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by this permit may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, within 14 days of receipt of this permit. Petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. Failure to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right such person may have to request an administrative determination (hearing) under section 120.57 Florida Statutes.

The Petition shall contain the following information;

- (a) The name, address, and the telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed;
- (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action; Compliance testing of this boiler shall be accomplished during a period when it is cycling up to a normal high firing rate, or it is continuously operated at a high firing rate. The permittee shall submit a statement of the operating mode as a part of the compliance test report. Failure to submit the input mode and an actual operation mode statement, or operating at conditions which do not reflect the normal operating conditions may invalidate the data. [Rule 17-4.070(3), F.A.C.].
- (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action;
- (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by petitioner, if any;
- (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrants reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action;
- (f) A statement of which rules or statutes petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

If a petition is filed, the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate agency action. Accordingly, the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any decision of the Department with regard to the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding. The petition must conform to the requirements specified above and be filed (received) within 14 days of receipt of this notice, in the Office of General Counsel at the above address of the Department. Failure to petition within the allotted time frame constitutes a waiver of any rights such person has to request a hearing under Section 120.57, F.S., and to participate as a party to this proceeding. Any subsequent intervention will only be at the approval of the presiding officer upon motion filed pursuant to Rule 28-5.207, F.A.C.

This permit is final and effective on the date filed with the Clerk of the Department unless a petition is filed in accordance with the above paragraphs or unless a request for extension of time in which to file a petition is filed within the time specified for filing a petition and conforms to Rule 17-103.070, F.A.C. Upon timely filing of a petition or a request for an extension of time this permit will not be effective until further Order of the Department.

When the Order (Permit) is final, any party to the Order has the right to seek judicial review of the Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department in the Office of General Counsel, 2600 Blair Street Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400; and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department.

- 2. The maximum allowable particulate emissions from each of the three (3) baghouse exhaust stacks shall not exceed 1.6 pounds per hour as part of a 1981 BACT determination and construction permit (AC53-23546) for the new DAP plant at this facility.
- 3. Visible emissions shall not be equal to or greater than 20% opacity in accordance with Rule 17-2.610(2)(A), F.A.C.
- 4. The maximum permitted operating rate for the multifos milling and sizing system is 25 tons per hour input.
- 5. Test each of the baghouse exhaust stack emissions for the following pollutant(s) at intervals of 12 months ± 1 month from September 5, 1990 and submit a copy of the test data to the Air Section of the Southwest District Office of the Department within 45 days of such testing. Testing procedures shall be consistent with the requirements of Section 17-2.700, F.A.C.:
- (X) Particulates *

- (X) Opacity
- * In lieu of a stack test, a Method 9 visible emissions test showing no visible emissions (less than 5% opacity) may be submitted pursuant to Rule 17-2.700(3)(d), F.A.C.

- 6. Compliance with the emission limitations of Specific Condition Nos. 2 and 3 shall be determined using EPA Methods 1,2,4,5 and 9 contained in 40 CFR 60, Appendix A and adopted by reference in Rule 17-2.700, F.A.C. The minimum requirements for stationary point source emissions test procedures and reporting shall be in accordance with Rule 17-2.700, F.A.C. and 40 CFR 60, Appendix A.
- 7. Testing of emissions must be conducted during operation within 10% of the maximum design capacity rate of 25 tons per hour. A compliance test submitted at an operating rate less than 90% of maximum permitted rate will automatically constitute an amended permit at the lesser rate until another test showing compliance at a higher rate is submitted. Failure to submit the operating rate and actual operating conditions may invalidate the test. [Rule 17-4.070(3), F.A.C.].
- 8. Should the Department have reason to believe the particulate emission standards not being met, the Department may require that compliance with the particulate emission standard be demonstrated by testing in accordance with Rule 17-2.700, F.A.C. [Rule 17-2.700(3)(d), F.A.C.].
- 9. The permittee shall notify the Southwest District Office of the Department at least 15 days prior to the date on which each formal compliance test is to begin of the date, time, and place of each such test, and the test contact person who will be responsible for coordinating and having such test conducted. [Rule 17-2.700(2)(a)9., F.A.C.].
- 10. Submit for this source, each calendar year, on or before March 1, an emission report for the preceding calendar year containing the following information pursuant to Subsection 403.061, F.S.:
 - (A) Annual amount of materials and/or fuels utilized;
 - (B) Annual emissions (note calculation basis);
 - (C) Any changes in the information contained in the permit.

The report shall be submitted to the Southwest District Office of the Department.
