Re: Modification of Permit No. AC 53-099108

The above permit is amended as stated below in response to IMC's letter dated May 6, 1991.

Specific Condition No. 2

Present:

Phosphorus bearing feed material to the modified plant shall not exceed 2,151 ton per day P_2O_5 input (2,000 TPD P_2O_5 product) and 92 TPH P_2O_5 production. Raw material input shall be monitored as required by 40 CFR 60.203. All records shall be kept for a minimum of 2 years.

New:

Phosphorus bearing feed material to the modified plant shall not exceed 2,366 ton per day P_2O_5 input (2,200 TPD P_2O_5 product) and 92 TPH P_2O_5 production. Raw material input shall be monitored as required by 40 CFR 60.203. All records shall be kept for a minimum of 2 years.

This amendment letter shall become a part of construction permit AC 53-099108.
