Dear Mr. Reynolds:

As we had discussed in our phone conversation on May 1, 1991, I am requesting the following construction permit condition change. This is to be done in order to modify the recently issued Operating Permit A053-192132. These permits cover the No. 3 Phosphoric Acid Train at the IMC Fertilizer New Wales facility.

The change is for Specific Condition No. 2. The condition should be changed as follows:

2. Phosphorus bearing feed material to the modified plant shall not exceed ~~2,151~~ 2,366 ton per day P<sub>2</sub>O<sub>5</sub> input (~~2,000~~ 2,200 TPD P<sub>2</sub>O<sub>5</sub> product) and 92 TPH P<sub>2</sub>O<sub>5</sub> production. Raw material shall be monitored as required by 40 CFR 60.203. All records shall be kept for a minimum of 2 years.


These changes make all the referenced production rates in this condition consistent. This change is requested to provide a reasonable margin of error for the increased monitoring requirements in the last operating permit. This does not reflect any change in annual production for this unit.
