The Department received your October 20 letter requesting two year extensions of the subject permits due to a market downturn in the phosphate industry.

Eighteen month extensions can be granted without re-evaluating the BACT analysis, however, for two year extensions, a condition would have to be added requiring re-evaluation of the BACT analysis before construction begins (F.A.C. Rule 17-212.410(2)). If you want us to process the two year extension with BACT re-evaluation required, please advise. RE: Request for Extension of Permit Expiration Dates

Dear Mr. Lewis:

We request that the expiration dates for two active IMC-Agrico Air Construction Permits be extended in the following manner:

AC53-199112, Modification of the Nos. 10 & 11 Sulfuric Acid Plants at the South Pierce Chemical Plant, from January 1, 1994 to January 1, 1996. The need for this extension is due to unfavorable financial circumstances at the present time. The work that remains for this permit is the installation of a waste heat recovery boiler in the No. 11 Unit. All other work covered by the permit has been completed. The boiler cannot be installed in the next major maintenance of Unit 11 but will be installed during the following one. This will occur within the two year period requested.

AC53-222859, Installation of an Animal Feed Ingredient Air Classifier and Controls at the New Wales Chemical Plant, from January 31, 1994 to January 31, 1996. The need for this extension is also due to unfavorable financial circumstances at the present time. The funds for this project are expected within a year. The additional time beyond the first year will be needed for the installation of the equipment.

Since both of these units were approved under PSD review, we understand that there will be additional procedural steps required in the permitting process due to these delays. They will be initiated in a timely manner.




