Dear Mr. Fancy:

This is to acknowledge receipt of an application for a Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit for the above referenced facility by your letter dated December 11, 1992. The major modification proposed consists of the addition of a new air classification system to an animal feed ingredients (AFI) plant at the above referenced location. As discussed between Mr. John Reynolds of your staff and Mr. Stan Kukier of my staff on January 5, 1993, we have reviewed the application as submitted and have the following comment:

Based upon a review of EPA background documents and BACT determinations for other recently permitted dry food product processing facilities, it is recommended that the applicant provide additional information indicating why a lower exit grain loading emission limit could not be met. An emission limit of 0.005 gr/dscf was recently permitted (PSD-TN-131, 5/23/91) for pulse-type baghouse control of an A.E. Staley corn starch processing facility's spray drier system. An emission limit of 0.01 gr/dscf was also permitted for conventional baghouse control of several material handling operations at the same facility. An emission limit of 0.005 gr/dscf was also permitted (CA-0131, 1/24/86) for baghouse control of a pneumatic almond separation process. The additional information indicates that a pulse-type baghouse collector exit grain loading concentration of 0.01 gr/dscf or lower may be feasible.

Dear Mr. Fancy:

We have completed our review of the IMC Fertilizer, Inc., permit application for the proposed product air classifier at the Animal Feed Ingredients (AFI) Plant at Mulberry, Florida. The AFI Plant is located approximately 102 km southeast of the Chassahowitzka Wilderness Area (WA), a Class I air quality area, administered by the Fish and Wildlife Service.

Particulate matter is the only pollutant that will be emitted in significant amounts from the proposed product air classifier. IMC performed the Level 1 VISCREEN screening analysis to evaluate potential visibility impacts in the Chassahowitzka WA from this source. The source passed this analysis; and, therefore, has low potential for causing visibility impairment due to plumes in the wilderness area.

Based on the visibility modeling results, the relatively low emissions, and the distance from the Chassahowitzka WA, we do not anticipate that resources in the wilderness area will be adversely affected by emissions from this facility.

Thank you for giving us the opportunity to comment on this permit application. We appreciate your cooperation in notifying us of proposed projects with the potential to impact the air quality and related resources of our refuges.
