SUBJ: IMC Fertilizer, Inc. request for after-the-fact permitting of the GTSP production operations to be allowed the use of fuel oil having 2.5% sulfur content, by weight, instead of 1.0%

Based on discussions with Gary Smallridge (OGC) and a review of the data and files, the following is offered:

- o For the GTSP production operation and pursuant to F.A.C. Rules 17-2.100(136)(b), Modification, and 17-2.500(2)(c)4., PSD-Applicability, there has not been a federally enforceable permit limit issued restricting the use of fuel oil to 1.0% sulfur content, by weight, since January 6, 1975; also, the facility/source is capable of accommodating fuel oil having 2.5% sulfur content, by weight; and,
- o The Department has permitted the use of fuel oil having 2.5% sulfur content, by weight, since that date (i.e., DAP: May 5, 1980 (AC 53-23546)).

Therefore, it is recommended that you issue an after-the-fact construction permit at the requested level.
