Attached to this letter is an "Affidavit of Publication" for the Department's Intent to Issue for the above draft permit. This notice was placed in the Polk County Democrat which is published in Bartow, FL. Our Noralyn facility is also located in Bartow, FL.

The notice was published on January 7, 1991. Proof of publication was received in my office on January 10, 1991.

We have the following comments pertaining to the draft permit:

1. Specific condition 2 of the draft permit states that "phosphate rock input shall not exceed the nominal 50 tons per hour as stated in the application". On page 4 of the original application (Section III.B.1) we stated that the total process input rate was 50 tons/hr. This information is a typographical error. Section III.A above and Attachment A of the application clearly state that the process rate is 723 tons/hr. Specific condition 2 of the draft permit should be modified to correct this error. We apologize for the inconvenience caused by this error.

STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATION NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE

The Department of Environmental Regulation hereby gives notice of its intent to issue a permit to IMC Fertilizer, Inc., Noralyn Mine Road, Bartow, Florida 33830 to relocate an existing scrubber at their Noralyn phosphate rock processing facility near Bartow in Polk County. A determination of Best Available Control Technology (BACT) was not required. The Department is issuing this Intent to Issue for the reasons stated in the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the Department's proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57, Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the infor-mation set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Depart-ment at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, within fourteen (14) days of publication of this notice. Petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indi-cated above at the time of filing. Failure to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right such person may have to request an admini-strative determination (hearing) under Section 120.57, Florida Statutes.
The Petition shall contain the

following information; (a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of the Department's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by the Department's action or proposed action; (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by Petitioner, if any; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; (f) A statement of which rules or statutes petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the Department's action or proposed action.

If a petition is filed, the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate agency action. Accordingly, the Depart-ment's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any decision of the Department with regard to the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding. The petition must conform to the requirements specified above and be filed (received) within 14 days of publication of this notice in the Office of General Counsel at the above address of
