The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue an onstruction permit modification to Florida Power Corporation (FPC) to defer the applicability date lower nitrogen oxides emission limit at its 258 megawatt congeneration facility located live miles we fout Meade. Polk County. A Bost Available Control Technology (BACT) determination was registed pursuant to Rules 22-12 (20) and 410. FAC. Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD). It emit modification will not cause a violation of any state or federal ambient air quality standards accernents. At present, the unit is in compliance with a nitrogen oxide (Nox) limit of 25 parts per million (ppa Conditions in alignial Permit No. AC-32-21493 (FSD-FL-190) were modified on January is 1997. The require that the unit achieve a nitrogen oxide (NOx) emission limit of 15 parts per million (ppm) who burning natural gas not later than December 31, 1998 using appropriate combustion technolog improvements or selective catalytic reduction (SCR). DESIEC (former owner) indicated to the Department at the time the canditions were modified that SCR would be installed by the December 31, 1998 date. DESIEC asserted that the cast of retrofitting this system with the Dry Low Nox combusts would be significantly greater than that of SCR. General Electric (manufacturer) and FPC have since agreed on terms that will make the DNI system cost effective.
