According to Condition A.33 of the Title V Permit No. 1050233-022-AV, TEC is required to perform prior to obtaining a renewed operating permit a formal compliance test demonstrating compliance for Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) while firing Syngas at Polk Power Station for E.U. ID No. 001. In addition condition 6 of the Air Construction Permit No. 1050233-021-AC requires VOC testing. Per Condition A.46, TEC shall file a report with the Department on the results of each test as soon as possible but no later than 45 days after the last sampling run of each test is completed.
