Mr. Sheplak,

After review, it appears that there are no outstanding compliance issues with this facility. I last performed an inspection there in August 2007 and found the facility to be in compliance. All reports (AORs, SOCs, excess emission reports) are submitted in a timely fashion. Compliance testing (CO and VE) and RATA (NOx) on EU 001 is conducted every FFY. VE testing on EU 003 was last done in April 2007. This unit used to supply steam to a facility next door that is no longer operating, so there is no need for Progress Energy to run it anymore. Another VE test on 003 was scheduled for April 2008 (unit was going to be restarted exclusively for the test), but was never conducted due to mechanical problems.

Per your discussion with Ann Quillian of Progress Energy's Environmental Services Section on December 1, 2005, the US Agri Chem ("USAC") facility in Ft. Meade, FL was shut down the week of November 21, 2005 and it is not expected to re-start its operation. The auxiliary boiler (Emissions Unit No. -003) on Progress Energy Florida's ("PEF") Tiger Bay facility had been providing steam to the USAC facility. In Section B., Emissions Unit Description on page 25 of the Title V Permit No. 1050223-012-AV, describes this activity.

In the past, PEF had used a portion of the steam from the boiler to start-up the combustion turbine (Emissions Unit No. -001). This shortened the start-up time and therefore resulted in less start-up emissions. With the permanent shutdown of the USAC Ft. Meade facility, PEF will continue to use this boiler to assist in start-up of the combustion turbine.

Per your request, PEF is requesting via this correspondence that the emissions unit description for the auxiliary boiler be updated with this change at the next re-opening of the Tiger Bay Title V Permit.
