The Department of Environmental Protection (permitting authority) gives notice of its intent to issue a Title V air operation permit revision to Tampa Electric Company to remove the requirement to utilize an opacity monitor on Emissions Unit 1.D.—001 for periodic monitoring and incorporates the use of a nitrogen oxide continuous emissions monitors to determine liquid fuel bound nitrogen content to the Polk Power Station located at 9995 State Route 37 South Mulberry, Polk County. The USEPA granted approval for the opacity monitor removal on May 9, 2001. The applicant's name and address are: Tampa Electric Company, P.O. Box 111, Tampa, Florida 33601, 0111.

The permitting authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed DRAFT Title V Permit Revision issuance action for operiod of 30 (thirty) days from the date of publication of this Notice, Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Moli Station #5505. Tollahassee, Florida 32399-2400. Any written comments fled shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in this DRAFT Title V Permit Revision, the permitting authority shall issue a Revised DRAFT Title V Permit Revision and require. If applicable, another Public Notice.

The permitting authority will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120.599 and 120.57, F.S. mediation under Section 120.573, F.S., will not be available for this proposed action.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision (revision) may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (felephone: 850/488-9730, Fax: 850/487-4938). Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the permitting authority's final action may be different from the positior taken by it in this notice of intent. Persons whose substantial interest will be affected by any such final decision of the permitting authority on the application have the right to petition to become a part to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forther addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code

to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above. In addition to the above, pursuant to 42 United States Code (U.S.C.) Section 7661d(b)(2), any person may petition the Administrator of the EPA within 60 (sixty) days of the expiration of the Administrator's 45 (forty-five) day review period as established at 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(1), to object to issuance of any permit revision. Any petition shall be based only on objections to the permit revision that were raised with reasonable specificity during the 30 (thirty) day public comment period provided in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates to the Administrator of the EPA that it was impracticable to raise such objections within the comment period or unless the grounds for such objection arose after the comment period. Filling of a petition with the Administrator of the EPA does not stoy the effective date of any permit properly issued pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 62-213. F.A.C. Petitions filled with the Administrator of EPA must meet the requirements of 42 U.S.C. Section 7661d(b)(2) and must be filled with the Administrator of the EPA at 401 M. Street. SW. Washington, D.C. 20460.
