Re: Request for Additional Information Regarding Change in Fuel Blend at Polk Power Station

File No.: 1050233-021-AC

Dear Mr. Hornick:

The Department has received your air construction permit application for the Polk Power Station for the purpose of increasing the allowable petcokc/coal fuel blend from 60/40% and 3.5% sulfur to 85/15% and 4.4% sulfur. However, in order to continue processing this application, the Department is requesting the additional information outlined below. Should your response to any of the listed items require new calculations or result in changes to the submitted information, please submit the new calculations, assumptions, reference material and appropriate revised pages of the application form, certified by your Professional Engineer.

The submitted information regarding the test burn results for sulfuric acid mist (SAM) emissions from the combustion turbine at the varying percentages of petcoke/coal do not follow a logical progression. One reason may be that the projected emissions were based on pounds per hour rather than on pounds per million British thermal units (lbs/MMBtu). The emissions of sulfur dioxide (SO₂) also appear to decrease as the sulfur content of the fuel blend increases. Furthermore, the application makes reference to possible modifications that may be made at the plant equipment to ensure that adequate sulfur removal from the syngas is achieved to avoid any significant increases in SO₂ and SAM emissions. We also understand that TECO is contemplating immediately following this application with a prevention of significant deterioration (PSD) application to further increase the sulfur percentage of the fuel blend to 6%. In order to approve either of these requests, a better understanding of future SO₂ and SAM emissions will be needed. If PSD is going to be avoided, sufficient monitoring will be needed to ensure that the future actual emissions do not increase above the significant emissions rates of 7 tons per year for SAM and 40 tons per year for SO₂.

- 1. Please provide an explanation for the unexpected trend in SAM emissions at the different fuel blends that were tested.
- 2. Please provide a comparison of past actual annual SO₂ and SAM emissions from the combustion turbine to future projected annual emissions on a lb/MMBtu basis. For reasonable assurance purposes, in addition to the SO₂ continuous emissions monitor, please propose a method for regularly monitoring emissions of SAM from the combustion turbine to ensure that there are no PSD significant emissions increases from the project.
- 3. Please propose and provide details for the control devices of methods that will be installed to avoid any significant increases in SO₂ and SAM emissions from the sulfuric acid plant. Also, for reasonable assurance purposes, please propose a method for regularly monitoring emissions of SO₂ and SAM from the sulfuric acid plant to ensure that there are no PSD significant emissions increases from the project.

4. If it is determined that it will be more expedient to process this request and the pending future request to burn 6% sulfur fuel at the same time, please provide a complete application for a PSD permit, including details and descriptions for any needed control devices that satisfy best available control technology (BACT) requirements.

The above comments require a written response to the Department within ninety days of receipt of this notice unless additional time is requested pursuant to Rule 62-4.055(1), F.A.C.
