Dear Mr. Holtom:

On April 8, 2009, Florida Power Corporation d/b/a Progress Energy Florida, Inc. ("PEF") completed the Hines Energy Complex Power Block 4 (PB4) Heat Recovery Steam Generator (HRSG) boiler tube cleaning project. If you recall from previous correspondence PEF informed the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP") of the temporary relocation of an 1160 horsepower (hp) back-up boiler to the Hines Energy Complex site, which was determined to be an insignificant emission unit by PEF. The purpose of the auxiliary boiler was as a backup in the event that the primary source of steam employed to heat the cleaning solution (the Power Block 3 (PB3) HRSG) became inoperable during the cleaning process. PEF would like to inform the Department that the use of the temporary auxiliary boiler was not necessary in this backup role and therefore was not fired/operated during the duration of the project.
