This facility manufactures fiberglass reinforced swimming pools and spas using styrene-based resins and gel coats in an open-molding technique. Styrene, a Hazardous Air Pollutant under Title III of the CAAA (1990) is the predominant species emitted, and is emitted in excess of 10 tons per year. The facility is therefore Major under that program, and a Title V permit has been issued to the facility.

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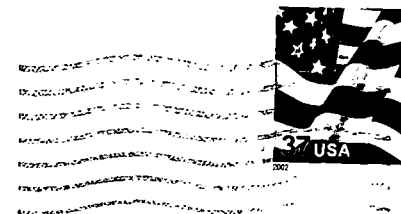
