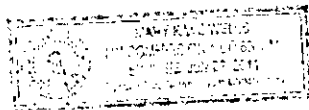

Facility Location: Georgia-Pacific Consumer Operations LLC operates the existing Georgia-Pacific Palatka Mill which is a pulp and paper mill located in Putnam County, North of County Road 216 and West of U.S. Highway 17 at Palatka, Florida.

Project: The Mill Recovery Boiler furnishes steam to the BLS to recover the cooking liquor as part of the recovery process of the mill. It is used in the recovery process to heat the black liquor to a temperature of 200 degrees Celsius. The boiler is currently operating at a capacity of 100,000 lbs of steam per hour. The applicant is proposing to increase the capacity of the boiler to 150,000 lbs of steam per hour. This increase will require the installation of a new boiler and associated piping. The applicant has provided assurance that operation of proposed equipment will not adversely impact air quality and that the project will comply with all applicable provisions of Chapter 380, F.S.

284, 420.10, 420.21, 420.26, and 420.27, F.A.C. The Permitting Authority will issue a Final Permit in accordance with the conditions of the proposed Draft Permit unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.56 and 120.57, F.S. or unless public comment received in accordance with this notice results in a different decision or a significant change of terms or conditions.

Comments: The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed Draft Permit for a period of 14 days from the date of publication of the Public Notice. Written comments must be postmarked by the Permitting Authority by close of business (5:00 p.m.) on or before the end of this 14-day period. If written comments received result in a significant change to the Draft Permit, the Permitting Authority shall revise the Draft Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Hearing. All comments filed will be made available for public inspection.

Petitioner: A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.56 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed with (received by) the Department's Agency Clerk at the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection at 3300 Government Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32309-0000. Petitions filed by any person other than those named in the written notice under Section 120.56(3), F.S. must be filed within 14 days of publication of this Public Notice. The fee for a written notice of a hearing or case fee, under Section 120.56(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Permitting Authority for review of any decision may file a petition after 14 days of receipt of that notice regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall send a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any petitioner to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that petitioner's right to request an administrative hearing under Chapter 120, F.S. or to intervene in any proceeding in the matter, as a party to it. Any intervenor shall be treated as a petitioner and shall be subject to the filing of a motion in compliance with rule 28.148.205, F.A.C.
