Applicant: The applicant for this project is Georgia-Pacific Consumer Operations, LLC. The applicant's authorized representative authorized representative and mailing address is: Gary L. Frost, Vice-Presid-ent Operations, Georgia-Pacific Consumer Opera-tions, LLC, Palatka Mill, Post Office Box 919, Pal-atka, Florida 32178.

Facility Location: Georgia-Pacific Consumer Operations, LLC operates the ex-isting Palatka Mill, which is located in Putnam County at 215 County Road 216 in Palatka, Florida.

Project: The applicant is proposing to replace the proposing to replace the residual oil startup burn-ers and load burners in the No. 4 Recovery Boller with new natural gas startup new natural gas startup burners, natural gas load burners and a new burner management system. The combustion of natural gas will be used for startup, shutdown and as a supplemental fuel in the No. 4 Recovery Boller instead of fuel oil. The total heat input to the boller from the combustion of natural gas. put to the boiler from the combustion of natural gas in the startup and load burners combined will be 664 million British thermal units/hour (MMBtu/hour). The applicant is requesting to limit the annual natural gas heat input to the current fuel oil limit of 1,178;220 MMBtu. during any consecutive 12 months. The conversion to natural gas will not increase the annual steam production rate.

Pipeline quality natural gas contains only trace amounts of ash, sulfur and other contaminants. Because the amount of natural gas that will be fired in the boiler on a heat input basis is equivalent to the currently used fuel oil, the Department does not expect emissions of any pollutant to exceed its significant emission rate with regard to the Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) program. The recovery boiler will remain subject to all existing emissions standards. The proposed project is scheduled to begin in July 2013 and continue through the annual outage in October 2013.

Permitting Authority: Applications for air construction permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-212 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and an air permit is required to perform the proposed work. The Permitting Authority responsible for making a permit.determination for this project is the Office of Permitting and Compliance in the Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Air Resource Management. 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Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit: The Permitting Authority gives notice of its intent to Issue an air construction permit to the applicant for the project described above. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that operation of proposed equipment will not adversely impact air quality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-296 and 62-210, 62-212, 62-296 and 62-297, F.A.C. The Permitting Authority will issue a Final Permit in accordance with the conditions of the proposed Draft Permit unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. or unless public comment received in accordance with this notice results in a different decision or a significant change of terms or conditions.

Comments: The Permitting Authority will accept writ-Authority will accept writ-ten comments concerning the proposed Draft Permit for a period of 14 days from the date of publica-tion of the Public Notice. Written comments must be received by the Permitting Authority by close of business (5:00 p.m.) on or before the end of this 14-day period. If written comments received received received to a comments received received received to a comments received recei period. If written com-ments received result in a significant change to the Draft Permit, the Permit-ting Authority shall revise the Draft Permit and re-quire, if applicable, anoth-er Public Notice. All com-ments filed will be made available for public received.

Petitions: A person whose substantial interests are af-fected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrat-ive hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and ve hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed with (recelved by) the Department's Agency Clerk in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection at 3990 Commonion tion at 3900 Common-wealth Boulevard, Mail Sta-tion #35, Tallahassee, Flor-ida 32399-3000. Petitions ida 32399-3000. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S. must be filed within 14 days of publication of this Public Notice or receipt of a written notice, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however any person who however, any person who asked the Permitting Au-thority for notice of agency action may file a petition within 14 days of receipt of within 14 days of recept of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above, at the time of filling. The fallure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a walver of that person's right to request an adminwalver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.
