Confirming our phone conversation of last week concerning the above draft permit, proposed Conditions of Certification D, Item 6 should state that the maximum weight of the petroleum coke burned shall not exceed 186,000 pounds per hour (averaged over 24 hours) in lieu of the 125,000 pounds per hour as shown in the draft. With your concurrence, the final Conditions of Certification will be so changed.
