On behalf of Tropicana Products, Inc., please accept the following comments relative to the above-referenced draft air permit for Tropicana's Fort Pierce, FL facility:

- 1. Section II, Specific Condition No. 21. Throughout the permit there are compliance testing requirements that state that tests are not required when burning fuel oil less than 400 hours per year. This condition, however, is not clear regarding when tests are not required. Tropicana requests that the following be added as a sentence at the end of this condition: "No compliance test is required for emissions that are not limited, nor where the test is specifically exempted by this permit."
- 2. Section III, Page 12-13, Conditions No. 2 and No. 11; Section III, Page 13-14, Conditions No. 2 and No. 11. These conditions reference the use of < 1.5% sulfur fuel oil for up to 400 hours per year. It is not clear whether the 400 hours is per emission unit or per entire facility. Tropicana requests clarification for this.
- 3. The emission unit descriptions (page 11 and 13) refer to No. 6 fuel oil. Since these units may burn either 1.5%, 0.5%. or 0.05% fuel oil, Tropicana requests that the specification of No. 6 be deleted and only the term "fuel oil" be used. The record keeping requirements on page 12, Specific Condition 12 should also be changed. We suggest that both daily and monthly requirements be changed from "No. 6 fuel oil usage by dryer" to "Fuel oil usage by sulfur type for each dryer".



The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit to Tropicana Products, Inc., for its existing citrus juice processing facility located at 6500 Glades Cutoff Road, Ft. Pierce, St. Lucie County. The applicant's mailing address is also: 6500 Glades Cutoff Road, Ft. Pierce, Florida 34981. The permit is to allow upgrades to the existing peel dryer burners so they can operate at 84 million 8tu per hour, heat input, and in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 403.08725, F.S.

The Department will issue the final permit with the attached conditions unless a response received in accordance with the following procedures results in a different decision or significant change of terms or conditions.

The Department will accept written comments concerning the proposed permit issuance action for a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Construction Permit. Written comments should be provided to the Department's Bureau of Air Regulation at 2600 Blar Stone Road, Mail Station #5505, Tallahassee, FL 32399-2400. Any written comments filed shall be made available for public inspection. If written comments received result in a significant change in the proposed agency action, the Department shall revise the proposed permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice.

The Department will issue the permit with the attached conditions unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed pursuant to Sections 120,569 and 120,57 Florida Statutes (F.S.), before the deadline for filing a petition. The procedures for petitioning for a hearing are set forth below.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative proceeding (hearing) under Sections 120,569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel of the Department at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant or any of the parties listed below must be filed within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent. Petitions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S., must be filed within fourteen days of publication of the public notice or within fourteen days of receipt of this notice of intent, whichever occurs first. Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Department for notice of agency action may file a petition within routteen act, sof receipt of that notice, regardless of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it. Any subsequent intervention will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205 of the Fiorida Administrative Code (F.A.C.).

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Department's action is based must contain the following information:

 (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known;

(b) The name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner, the name, address, and telephone number of the petitioner's representative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of now the petitioner's substantial interests will be affected by the agency determination:

(c) A statement of how and when cetitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed action
(d) A statement of all aispured issues of material fact. If

(d) A statement or oil aisputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate; (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or madification of the agency's proposed action;

(f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action; and

(g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, starting precisely the action petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action.

A petition that does not discute the material facts upon which the Department's action is cased shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise snall contain the same information as ser forth above, as required by Rule 28-106,301, F.A.C.
