Here are the answers to the questions about the recently submitted FMPA Treasure Coast Application.

- Since the application stated that operations started February 11, 2008, the 180 day deadline to submit the Title V Application was actually August 9, 2008. The Title V application was received August 11, 2008, so it was not timely. However, the current construction permit expires July 31, 2009. The Title V permit will need to be Final before that date to avoid any related compliance issues.
- 2. Since the application fee is based on potential emissions increases, the application appears to be a minor modification to the existing PSD permit (increase under 5TPY = \$250 fee). I caution that since we haven't done a full review and it is not explicitly stated in the application, our suggestion is for you to review the Application Fees information in 62-4.050 and send the fee amount appropriate for the request. 
