Dear Mr. Vanden Bergh:

On December 19, 2007, the Department received your air pollution operation permit renewal application to operate a power cable reclamation facility, located at 4198 East State Road 462, Wildwood, Sumter County, Florida. In order to continue processing the application, the Department will need the following additional information pursuant to Rules 62-4.055 and 62-4.070(1), F.A.C.:

- A copy of the most recent visible emission test report, conducted in the 12-month period prior to March 21, 2008, as required by Specific Condition Nos. 11 and 18.C. of your current operation permit (1190009-008-AO);
- An updated process description for the facility which removes references to the addition of dry chemical feed (see paragraph 2, lines 6-8 of the Process Description), and any other changes necessary to reflect the operation of this facility; and
- A corrected Process Flow Diagram which reflects the correct location of the granulator and removes references to the chemical feed, and any other changes necessary to reflect the operation of this facility.
