This project is for the renewal of the operation permit for Robbins Manufacturing Company. This sawmill facility produces untreated wood products such as utility poles and lumber and includes two wood fired boilers , two kilns, a sawdust silo and a planer shaving storage bin. One of the boilers (EU ID No 002) has been shutdown since 9/6/2009 and was given a permit expiration date of 9/6/2014, which is 5 years from the date of shutdown. This is in accordance with rule 62-210.300(2)(a)3.b., F.A.C.

The enforcement status of this facility was reviewed by Mr. Jim McDonald. His comments were received via email on January 21, 2011. He commented that the facility did not have any open or closed enforcement cases within the past five years.

Mr. Malik Pickering, Ms. Brandy Flavors and I visited this facility as part of the permit renewal process on February 4, 2011 and found that the emissions units described in the permit adequately represented the equipment and processes at the plant. Mr. Pickering submitted his comments regarding the facility to me via email on February 10, 2011 and stated that he no recommended changes for the permit.

I recommend issuance of this permit.
