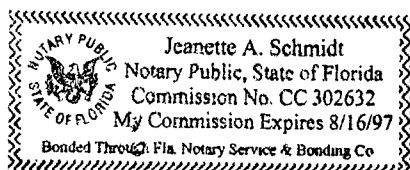

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE PERMIT

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice  
of its intent to issue an air pollution permit (No. AC60-275105) to  
Florida Crushed Stone Co./Consolidated Minerals Inc. for the  
after-the-fact construction of a limestone processing plant at  
its facility located at the St. Catherine Mine, Highway 673, Cen-  
ter Hill, Florida.

A Best Available Control Technology (BACT) determination  
was not required.

A person whose substantial interests are affected by this  
proposed permitting decision may petition for an administra-  
tive proceeding (hearing) in accordance with Section 120.57,  
Florida Statutes. The petition must contain the information set  
forth below and must be filed (received) in the Office of Gen-  
eral Counsel of the Department at 2600 Blair Stone Road, Talla-  
hassee, Florida 32399-2400, within 14 days of publication of this  
notice. Petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the ap-  
plicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. Fail-  
ure to petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver  
of any right such person may have to request an administra-  
tive determination (hearing) under section 120.57 Florida Stat-  
utes.

The Petition shall contain the following information: (a) The  
name, address, and the telephone number of each petitioner,  
the applicant's name and address, the Department Permit File  
Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b)  
A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice  
of the Department's action or proposed action; (c) A  
statement of how each petitioner's action or proposed action, if  
any; (d) A statement of the material facts disputed by the petitioner,  
if any; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends war-  
rants reversal or modification of the Department's action or  
proposed action; (f) A statement of which rules or statutes peti-  
tioner contends require reversal or modification of the Depart-  
ment's action or proposed action; and (g) A statement of the  
relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action peti-  
tioner wants the Department to take with respect to the De-  
partment's action or proposed action.

If a petition is filed, the administrative hearing process is de-  
signed to formulate agency action. Accordingly, the Depart-  
ment's final action may be different from the position taken by  
it in this permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be af-  
fected by any decision of the Department with regard to the  
application have the right to petition to become a party to  
the proceeding. The petition must conform to the require-  
ments specified above and be filed (received) within 14 days  
of receipt of this notice, in the Office of General Counsel at  
the above address of the Department. Failure to petition  
within the allotted time frame constitutes a waiver of any rights  
such person has to request a hearing under Section 120.57 F.S.,  
and to participate as a party to this proceeding. Any subse-  
quent intervention will only be at the approval of the presiding  
officer upon motion filed pursuant to Rule 28-5.207 F.A.C.

The application is available for public inspection during nor-  
mal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Fri-  
day, except legal holidays, at 8407 Laurel Fair Circle, Tampa,  
Florida 33610.
