

6.



Here's my suggestion for the footnote to explain the dual state/NSPS opacity standard for your upcoming final permit issuance.

Please note that in order to comply with the existing state opacity standard for stationary air curtain incinerators found in Rule 62-296.401(7)(a), F.A.C., and the new federal NSPS opacity standard found in 40 CFR 60, Subpart CCCC, adopted and incorporated by reference in Rule 62-204.800(7)(b)74., F.A.C., the operator must ensure that, outside of the first 30 minutes of daily operation, the opacity doesn't exceed 5%, except that an opacity of up to 10% is allowed for up to 3 minutes each hour. When this opacity condition is met, both DEP Method 9 and EPA Method 9 will show compliance with both the federal NSPS and the state opacity standards.

From the information below, I recommend the Intent to Issue for C.R. 466-A Landfill, L.L.C.'s natural non-Title V air curtain incinerator be signed. Day 90 is April 8, 2002.

On January 8, 2002, the Department received from C.R. 466-A Landfill, L.L.C. an air pollution permit application to construct an air curtain incinerator at a construction and demolition landfill located on the west side of the Sumter/Lake County line and on the south side of C.R. 466A. The incinerator is permitted to be charged at a rate of 1.4 tons/hr. (daily average) and a maximum of 3,500 tons per any consecutive 12 month period. The incinerator is also subject to 40 CFR 60, Subpart CCCC, which has been adopted by reference in Rule 62-204.800(7), F.A.C.

As we discussed, the permit has been drafted with condition/terms that are currently in the rulemaking process.

Compliance with the conditions/terms of the permit is demonstrated by visible emission testing and recordkeeping.

The applicant proposes to construct an air curtain incinerator at a construction and demolition landfill on the west side of the Sumter/Lake County line and on the south side of C.R. 466A.

D. Process and Controls:

The applicant is requesting permission for the construction of For the construction of an A.B.I., Air Curtain Incinerator, Model F-045 at a natural non-Title V facility. The incinerator is subject to the requirements of 40 CFR 60, Subpart CCCC and Rules 62-296.401(h) & 62-296.401(7), F.A.C. The incinerator's maximum material charging rate is 1.4 tons/hr. (daily average) and the maximum limit on the hours of charging is 2,500 hours per any consecutive 12 month period. The incinerator's earthen burning pit is not refractory lined and is 35 ft. long x 12 ft. wide x 10 ft. deep. Emissions from the incinerator will be controlled by forced air at a very high static pressure over and around the burning pit.

Air is supplied to the air curtain incinerator by a 67 HP diesel-powered fan, which is considered exempt from permitting per Rule 62-4.040, F.A.C.

This project is not subject to the Title V permitting requirements of Rule 62-213, F.A.C., since it is considered a natural non-Title V source.
