

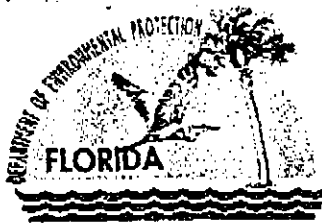

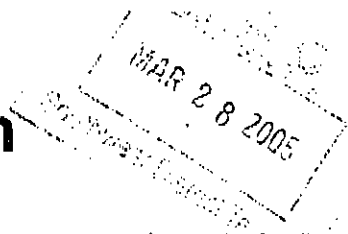

Dear Mr. Stavola:

The purpose of this letter is to complete the resolution of the matter previously identified by the Department in the Warning Letter No. WN03-0010-IW60D dated September 19, 2003, a copy of which is attached. The corrective actions required to bring your facility into compliance have been performed. The Department finds that you are in violation of the rules and statutes cited in the attached Warning Letter. In order to resolve the matters identified in the attached Warning Letter, you are assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$8,000.00, along with \$1,000.00 to reimburse the Department costs, for a total of \$9,000.00. The civil penalty is apportioned as follows: \$8,000.00 for violation of Rule 62-4.030, Florida Administrative Code. The Department acknowledges that the payment of these civil penalties by you does not constitute an admission of liability. This payment must be made payable to the Department of Environmental Protection by cashier's check or money order and shall include the OGC File Number assigned above and the notation "Ecosystems Management and Restoration Trust Fund." Payment shall be sent to the Department of Environmental Protection, 3804 Coconut Palm Drive, Tampa, Florida 33619-1352, within 30 days of your signing this letter.

Your signing this letter constitutes your acceptance of the Department's offer to resolve this matter on these terms. If you elect to sign this letter, please return it to the Department at the address indicated above. The Department will then countersign the letter and file it with the Clerk of the Department. When the signed letter is filed with the Clerk, the letter shall constitute final agency action of the Department, which shall be enforceable pursuant to Section 120.69 and 403.121, Florida Statutes.


