Facility Location: The applicant operates the existing Sumterville Cement Plant; which is located in Sumter County at 4750 E. CR 470, Sumterville, Florida

Project: The applicant applied on July 12, 2012, to the Department for a minor source air construction permit. The minor source all construction permit is for alternative fuels such as: tire-derived fuel; plastics; roofing materials; agricul-tural biogenic materials; cellulosic biomass - untreated; cellulosic biomass treated; carpet-derived fuel; alternative fuel mix; bio solids; and, engineered fuel. The minor source air construction permit is also for a production rate in-crease from 3,000 short tons of clinker per day (TPD) to 3,250 short TPD by tak-ing advantage of the exist 6 ing Portland cement manuut facturing plant's designed sy and as built capacity. 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This existing facility consists of a Portland cement plant and associated quarry, and raw material and cement handling operations. Air pollutant emission control techniques, measures and devices at the plant include: a selective non-catalytic re-duction (SNCR) system with ammonia injection in the preheater/calciner for the control of nitrogen oxides (NOx) emissions, combus-tion devices & techniques like low-NOx burners in the klin, an indirect firing system by the burners in the kiln, staged combustion in preheater/calciner complete combustion in the kiln and calciner, and minimizing carbon and olly content of raw materials to minimize carbon monoxide (CO) and volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions; low sulfur content fuels and raw materials along with natural lime process scrub-bing in the calciner for the control of sulfur dioxide (SO2) emissions; and a main baghouse, numerous other baghouses for the control of particulate matter (PM/PM10) emissions and employing reasonable precautions to minimize fual tive PM/PM10 emissions.
The plant is already equipped with a certified continuous opacity monitor-lng system (COMS) for visible emissions (VE), certified continuous emissions moni-toring systems (CEMS) for NOx, total hydrocarbons (THC) (THC is a surrogate for VOC), SO2 and mercury

Permitting Authority: Applications for air construction permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-212 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements. The Office of Permitting and Compliance is the Permitting Authority

responsible for making a permit determination for this project. The Permitting Authority's physical address is: 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, "Florida. Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permits: The Permitting Authority gives notice of its intent to Issue an air construction permit for the project described above. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-201, 62-212, 62-214, 62-296 and 62-297, F.A.C. The Permitting Authority will issue final permit in accordance with the conditions of the draft air construction permit unless a response receiver: accordance with the folic\_ing procedures results in a different decision, or a significant change of terms or conditions.

Petltions filed by any persons other than those entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S. must be filed within 14 days of publication of the Public Notice or receipt of a written notice, whichever occurs first Under Section 120.60(3), F.S., however, any person who asked the Permitting Authority for notice of agency action may file a petition within 14 days of re-ceipt of that notice, regard-less of the date of publication. A petitioner shall mall a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address inappricant at the address in-dicated above, at the time of filing. The fallure of any person to file a petition within the appropriate time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S., or to intervene in this proceeding and participate as a party to it.

Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the approval of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which the Permitting Authority's action is based must contain the following information: (a) The name and address of each agency affected and each agency's file or identification number, if known; (b) The name, address and telephone number of the petitioner; the name ad-dress and telephone number of the petitioner's repre-sentative, if any, which shall be the address for service purposes during the course of the proceeding; and an explanation of how the peti-tioner's substantial rights will be affected by the agency determination; (c) A statement of when and how the petitioner received no-tice of the agency action or proposed decision; (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petition must so indicate; (e) A concise statement of the other statement of the oth cise statement of the ulti-mate facts alleged, includ-ing the specific facts the pertioner contends warrant eversal or modification of the agency's proposed ac-tion; (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed ac-tion including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules

or statutes; and; (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106:301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permits. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Mediation: Mediation is not available for this proceed-ing.
