Project: The applicant requested a 180-day extension to install the Mercury Emissions Continuous Monitoring System due to the economy and decreased demand for cement production. The cement plant has operated at 23.6% of its capacity over the past eleven months due to the decreased demand for cement. The applicant monitors the mercury inputs through a material balance and the permit limits remain the same. This revision does not change any federal requirements.
