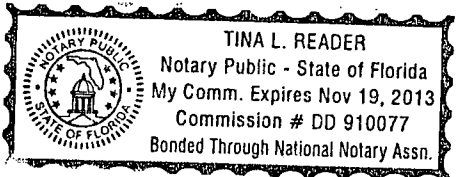

**Applicant:** The applicant for this project is American Cement Company, L.L.C. The applicant's authorized representative and mailing address is: Cary Cohrs, President, American Cement Company, Sumterville Cement Plant, P.O. Box 445, Sumterville, FL 33585.

**Facility Location:** American Cement Company, L.L.C. operates the existing Sumterville Cement Plant which is located in Sumter County at 4750 E. County Road 470 in Sumterville.

**Project:** The applicant requested a 180-day extension to install the Mercury Continuous Emissions Monitoring System due to the economy and decreased demand for cement production. The cement plant has operated at 23.6% of its capacity over the past eleven months due to the decreased demand for cement. The applicant monitors the mercury inputs through a material balance and the permit limits remain the same. This revision does not change any federal requirements.

Permitting Authority (Applications for Air Construction

permits are subject to review in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 403, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Chapters 62-4, 62-210 and 62-212 of the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). The proposed project is not exempt from air permitting requirements and any air permit is required to perform the proposed work. The Permitting Authority is responsible for making a permit determination for this project is the Bureau of Air Regulation in the Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Air Resource Management. The Permitting Authority's physical address is: 111 South Magnolia Drive, Suite #4, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400. The Permitting Authority's telephone number is 850/488-0114.

**Project File:** A complete project file is available for public inspection during the normal business hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday (except legal holidays) at the physical address indicated above for the Permitting Authority. The complete project file includes the Draft Permit, the Technical Evaluation and Preliminary Determination, the application, and information submitted by the applicant (exclusive of confidential records) under Section 403.114 F.S.). Interested persons may contact the Permitting Authority's project engineer for additional information at the address and phone number listed above. **Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit:** The Permitting Authority gives notice of its intent to issue an air construction permit to the ap-

licant for the project described above. The applicant has provided reasonable assurance that operation of proposed equipment will not adversely impact air quality and that the project will comply with all appropriate provisions of Chapters 62-4, 62-204, 62-210, 62-212, 62-296 and 62-297 F.A.C. The Permitting Authority will issue a Final Permit in accordance with the conditions of the proposed Draft Permit unless a timely petition for an administrative hearing is filed under Sections 120.569 and 120.571 F.S. or unless public comment received in accordance with this notice results in a different decision or a significant change of terms or conditions.

**Comments:** The Permitting Authority will accept written comments concerning the proposed Draft Permit for a period of 14 days from the date of publication of this Public Notice. Written comments must be received by the Permitting Authority by close of business (5:00 p.m.) on or before the end of the 14-day period. If written comments received result in a significant change to the Draft Permit, the Permitting Authority shall revise the Draft Permit and require, if applicable, another Public Notice. All comments filed will be made available for public inspection.

**Petitions:** A person whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed permitting decision may petition for an administrative hearing in accordance with Sections 120.569 and 120.571 F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed with (received by) the Department's Agency Clerk in the Office of General Counsel of the Department of Environmental Protection at 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mall Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000 (Telephone: 850/245-2241).

**Mediation:** Mediation is not available for this proceeding.

(c) A statement of when and how the petitioner received notice of the agency action or proposed decision. (d) A statement of all disputed issues of material fact. If there are none, the petitioner must so state. (e) A concise statement of the ultimate facts alleged, including the specific facts the petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action. (f) A statement of the specific rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of the agency's proposed action, including an explanation of how the alleged facts relate to the specific rules or statutes, and; (g) A statement of the relief sought by the petitioner, stating precisely the action the petitioner wishes the agency to take with respect to the agency's proposed action. A petition that does not dispute the material facts upon which the Permitting Authority's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above as required by Rule 28.106.301, F.A.C. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the Permitting Authority's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this Public Notice of Intent to Issue Air Permit. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the Permitting Authority on the application have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding. In accordance with the requirements set forth above, mediation is not available for this proceeding.

Dear Mr. Koerner:

American Cement Company, LLC kindly requests the department to grant a 180 day extension related to the installation of its stack mercury emissions monitor.

Our Permit (No. 119-0042-001-AC) requires the installation to be installed within 60 days following initial clinker production. Over the past 11 months we have struggled with various design issues in the plant and only recently complete our stack emission testing. To date the plant has only operated at 23.6% of its capacity.

American Cement Company continues to monitor our mercury inputs via material balance and operate the plan in strict accordance with our permit limits. The 180 day extension will afford us the opportunity to address the remaining design issues and evaluate properly the mercury monitor to be installed. Clearly, we are suffering during this economic downturn and the extension will allow us more time to purchase a strong system economically.
